Citizens Advice Belfast, provides an outreach surgery at Cancer Lifeline once a week. This will allow you to get help and advice on what benefits you may be entitled to and any financial or practical help available. The benefits adviser will help you fill out any official forms required.

Maximising Income

While there is a growing number of people who are now surviving cancer, research shows many people diagnosed often suffer a loss of income due to their inability to work.

Benefit Retrieval

Over the past few years, Cancer Lifeline, through the engagement of Citizen's Advice have been able to re-coup in excess of £100,000 (annually) on behalf of cancer patients and their families in North Belfast.
